UKRAINE IS IN NEED FOR SUPPORT



STATUS REPORT // JUNE 2022

The Norwegian-Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce (NUCC) is a non-profit, non-governmental organization established by and for Norwegian and Ukrainian companies.

Since Russia launched a full-scale invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022, NUCC has experienced extensive engagement by its members and partners in providing humanitarian financial donations to Ukrainian civilians, civic organizations, and the Ukrainian civil society. NUCC members have requested NUCC to identify emergency needs and relevant humanitarian organizations and emergency projects which can receive financial donations from NUCC members, partners, and individual donors with assistance and support from NUCC.

Against this background, the NUCC Board of Directors unanimously resolved on 1 March 2022 to establish an ad hoc fundraising to collect and channel to Ukrainian humanitarian organizations and emergency projects financial funds provided by NUCC members, partners, and individual donors.

Dobrovdii

Dobrovdii is a charitable foundation in the city of Sumy, founded by Iuliia Isai in 2016. Sumy is a region in the North East of Ukraine that has been heavily affected by the war. The foundation works to help the local people of Sumy, the territorial defense, and local hospitals. Your support has provided medicine and medical equipment to a local children's hospital.

Egersund Seafood Ukraine

Egersund Seafood is a Ukrainian company co-owned by NUCC member Pelagia with seafood shops, restaurants, and kitchens in Kyiv and Lviv. When the war started, the company started its humanitarian efforts by delivering free-of-charge food to soldiers, hospitals, and orphanages. Food was sent from border countries, as well as from Norway. Egersund Seafood is now returning to business as usual.

Tschudi Logistics Holding and the Norwegian consulate in Odesa

Tschudi and the Consulate are working to deliver shipments of food, medicine, and hygiene articles to children with autism in the southern regions of Ukraine. NUCC member Tschudi Logistics Holding in Oslo arranges logistics. Norway's consul in Odesa, Oleg Fomichov, with the Tschudi Ship Management Ukraine team, work to distribute the goods on the ground in Odesa, Kherson, Mykolaiv, and more.



Help Ukraine

Help Ukraine is a joint initiative of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, Rozetka, Fozzy Group, TIS, Dragon Capital, Novaya Pochta, Spunbond fund, and RZTK for international partners. They provide humanitarian and medical aid to the people of Ukraine. Help Ukraine has launched a Warehouse Distribution Center in Poland to organize the delivery of goods.

Ukrainahjelpen Karmøy has been supporting and carrying out humanitarian and social work in Ukraine since 1994. Since 2014, they have collaborated closely with a local partner, Hope from heart to heart. Since the first week of the war, their team of volunteers has been driving columns of vans from a village in the Carpathians to central and Eastern Ukraine, bringing humanitarian aid to the people in need and assisting with evacuation where it is needed. Your kind support has financed the purchase of two vans for this purpose and several tonnes of supplies.

Aspaklariya is a Ukrainian NGO operating from Lviv. They buy mainly food, medicine, and hygiene articles in the West of Ukraine and bring them to the most war-affected areas in Eastern Ukraine, such as Kharkiv. In addition to this, they have been supporting the territorial defense with clothes and other necessary equipment. Aspaklariya organizes its work based on a hand-to-hand principle with trusted locals in the affected areas to ensure that the help does not get lost along the way but goes directly to where it is the most needed.
